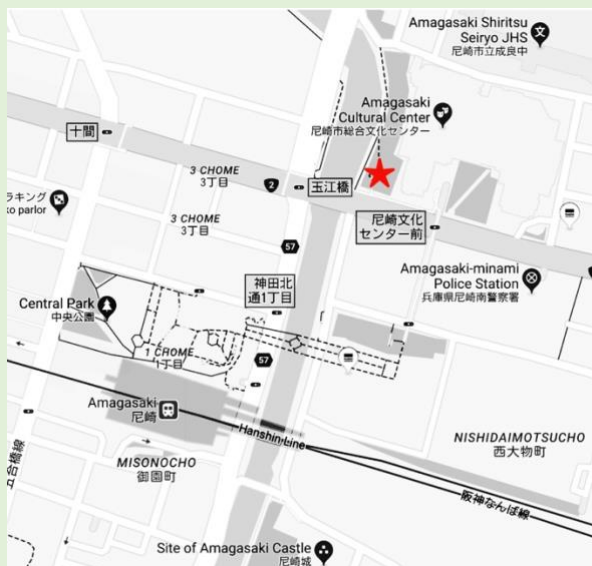
#### By train

7 minutes from Umeda, 20 minutes from Namba or 22 minutes from Sannomiya (HANSHIN Railway)

5minutes walk from **Hanshin Amagasaki Station**

#### From JR Amagasaki station

Take the Hanshin Bus (23line)  
Get off the "Amagasaki Sogo Bunka Center" bus stop and walk for 5min.



#### By air

**Osaka international Airport** (Airport bus: approx. 30 minutes) Hanshin Koshien station (Walk) Koshien station (Hanshin Main Line Limited Express. 5 minutes) - Hanshin Amagasaki station / (Osaka Monorale:3 minutes) - Hotarugaik station (Hankyu Takarazuka Line Express:14 minutes) - Hankyu Umeda station (Walk) - Hanshin Umeda station (Hanshin Main Line Express: 10 minutes) - Hanshin Amagasaki station

**Kansai International Airport** (JR Kansai Airport Rapid Service: 58 minutes) Get off at Nishikujo station (And change to Hanshin Namba Line: 12 minutes) to Hanshin Amagasaki station (Airport bus: approx. 52 minutes) - Hanshin Amagasaki station

**Kobe Airport** (Kobe New Transit Port Liner: 18 minutes) to Sannomiya station, Change to Hanshin Main Line( 23 minutes) to Hanshin Amagasaki station
